

Time needed 8 hours

Technical requirements smartphone/tablet or camera with computer; internet connection

Goal To become aware of the role of "places" as part of our lives. Places are associated with memories, emotions, people or events. Some places may be associated with a particular time in our lives. Places also connect us with other people, especially when we share the same favourite places.

Short description "Lieblingsorte" is a photo task combined with a short text. You will focus on one place and think of a short message you would like to convey. It should be a personal story and not a technical, tourist description. The results will be shared within the teams. As an option, you can upload your photo story on an open street map and connect with other people around the world who might want to do the same.

Steps

1. Choose a favourite place you would like to present and think of your "story".
2. Go to your favourite place and take at least five different photos. Try different camera positions to get the best impression of what you want to convey.
3. Write a short text about your favourite place (at least five sentences).
4. Share and discuss your photo story with your team / EU team. Watch and read the other stories, look for connections to your stories or experiences.
5. Option: Put your photo story on an open street map. You can set up your own team project with the umap project (<https://umap.openstreetmap.fr/en/>). We can also put your story on the Kulturring map below.
