

Introduction to video editing video task 3

Time needed 4 hours

Technical requirements smartphone/tablet or camera with computer; internet connection

Goals

1. Learn how to record short movies and make adjustments with your mobile phone camera
2. Learning about online social media and video platforms and discussing their content

Short description "Introduction to video editing" is an opportunity to continue working with the video clips from video task 2. The workshop facilitator gives a walkthrough to show how film clips can be adjusted and how text can be inserted. The three film clips can be put together to form a single film file instead of 3 separate film clips. For those who want to go further, you can adjust the volume, add music and text.

Steps

1. As a group, think about which social platforms feature video. What types of videos are shared on these platforms? Does anyone in the group use them and if so, how?
2. Decide on an editing programme, Instagram has an editing function but a maximum of 2 minutes. VN Editor was chosen by our group as many do not want to be seen on social media.
3. Open the programme, import the previously recorded clips
4. Drag the beginning and end of the movie clip or use the scissors (cut) tool and delete the part you want to remove.
5. Add sound and adjust the sound levels
6. Add text, decide where to put it
7. Export the movie and see where it ends up on your phone, the Internet, etc.
8. Watch all the films together as a group and allow time for discussion.
